## TRASH:

**Candy Wrappers:** Candy wrappers are made of a mixture of materials and make them difficult to recycle. **Plastic Bag:** Plastic bags can't be recycled in your regular recycling bin because they get tangled up in the machine at the recycling facility. Check your local grocery store for a plastic bag recycling collection bin. **Styrofoam:** Styrofoam is a material that is also difficult to recycle.

**Plastic Straw:** Plastic straws are too small and lightweight to make it through the sorting machines at the recycling facility so they go in trash.

## **RECYCLE:**

**Plastic Bottle, Glass Jar, Soda Can:** Aluminum cans, glass, and rigid plastics can all be placed in recycling. Note: Your local waste hauler may have restrictions on the types of plastic accepted. **Newspaper:** As long as the newspaper is not wet, it should go in the recycling bin.

## **COMPOST:**

Apple Core, Banana Peel: All fruit and vegetable waste can be composted in both backyard and commercial composting facilities.

**Chicken:** Meat and dairy can be composted in commercial composting facilities but not in your backyard composter. **Egg Shells:** Egg shells are a rich source of calcium and other essential nutrients that plants need.
